

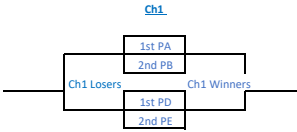

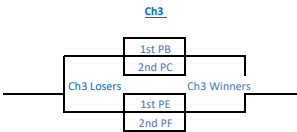
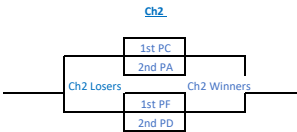

- *The (2) byes in Gold and Silver Bracket play are determined by:
- 1) Overall team record in both pool and challenge round play
 - 2) Pairs win/loss percentage in both pool and challenge round play
 - 3) Set win/loss percentage in both pool and challenge round play (total set)
 - 4) Point differential percentage (total points won/total points played)
 - 5) Higher seeded team



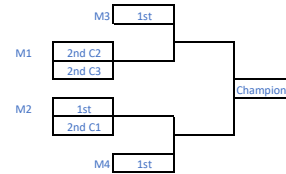
- Bye Determination Example:
- 1) School is 4-0 at conclusion of day 2 challenge round matches - win perc
 - 2) Match 1 score: 3-0; Match 2 score: 3-1; Match 3 score: 3-0; Match 4 score: 3-0
Total pair record 12-3; Pairs win/loss percentage is 80%
 - 3) Match 1 set record: 6-1; Match 2 set record: 7-3; Match 3 set record: 6-0
Set win/loss record 27-10; Set win/loss percentage is 73%



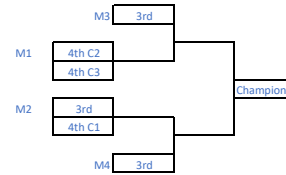
